- AN ACT Relating to providing immunity for school bus drivers; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 28A.160 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 28A.160 RCW to read as follows:
- A school bus driver who has a valid commercial driver's license issued in accordance with chapter 46.25 RCW is immune from civil or criminal liability for acts that (1) the driver reasonably believes
- 9 are necessary, (2) are taken in good faith and without gross
- 10 negligence, (3) are taken during the course of his or her duties, and
- 11 (4) are taken when coming to the aid of another person that the
- 12 driver reasonably believes is in imminent danger of bodily injury or
- 13 death.
