- 2 and the surrounding areas; and adding a new section to chapter 72.23
- 3 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 72.23 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) Western state hospital shall enter into a contract with the 8 city in which it is located for the provision of community policing 9 services at the hospital and in the surrounding areas.
- 10 (2) For the purposes of this section, community policing services 11 includes, but is not limited to, a neighborhood patrol officer, service officer, 12 community and detective or investigator 13 proactively address public safety issues at the hospital such as 14 interacting with the public to increase communication between city government and the public, investigating complaints of patient and 15 16 staff related incidents, and conducting training.
- 17 (3) Beginning in fiscal biennium 2015-2017, the contract 18 described in subsection (1) of this section must be no less than four 19 hundred sixty-two thousand dollars. In each subsequent fiscal

- 1 biennium, the contract must increase by one percent, but may never
- 2 exceed seven hundred fifty thousand dollars.
