- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The department of ecology must complete a study that analyzes the current extent of light pollution that adversely affects the quality of the environment, the value of
- 9 property, and the health and well-being of the public. The study
- 10 must, at minimum, evaluate:
- 11 (a) The risks to public health, well-being, and the environment 12 posed by light pollution;
 - (b) The locations in the state with the greatest prevalence of light pollution and the greatest impacts of light pollution on environmental quality, ecosystem function, and public well-being; and
- 16 (c) Policy options for addressing light pollution that have been 17 adopted by other jurisdictions.
- 18 (2) By January 1, 2017, the department of ecology must submit a 19 report containing its analysis and recommendations to the appropriate 20 fiscal and policy committees of the legislature. The recommendations
