- 1 AN ACT Relating to the state auditor including allowing for 2 audits to be conducted by a private entity and establishing an appeal
- 3 process; amending RCW 43.09.245; and adding a new section to chapter
- 4 43.09 RCW.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.09.245 and 1995 c 301 s 14 are each amended to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(1)</u> The state auditor has the power to examine all the financial affairs of every local government and its officers and employees.
- 10 (2) Local governments may request a financial audit from a
- 11 private entity in lieu of an audit by the state auditor. The state
- 12 <u>auditor must approve the request. Any entity performing a financial</u>
- 13 <u>audit under this section must meet generally accepted government</u>
- 14 <u>auditing standards.</u>
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 43.09
  RCW to read as follows:
- 17 A state agency or local government may appeal the results of any
- 18 audit pursuant to the administrative procedure act. The audit report
- 19 may not be made public until the appeal process is complete and the
- 20 results of the appeal addressed. The state auditor shall adopt

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- 1 appropriate rules which must include that the presiding officer of
- 2 the appeal shall be an administrative law judge assigned by the
- 3 office of administrative hearings in accordance with chapter 34.12
- 4 RCW. The provisions of RCW 34.05.425 regarding disqualification for
- 5 bias, prejudice, interest, or any other cause apply.

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
