- 1 AN ACT Relating to flamethrowing devices; adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 43.43 RCW; adding a new chapter to Title 70 RCW; and
- 3 prescribing penalties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The definitions in this section apply
- 6 throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires
- 7 otherwise.
- 8 (1) "Director of fire protection" means the director of fire protection appointed under RCW 43.43.938.
- 10 (2) "Flamethrowing device" means any nonstationary and
- 11 transportable device designed or intended to emit or propel a burning
- 12 stream of combustible or flammable liquid a distance of at least ten
- 13 feet. "Flamethrowing device" does not include any drip torch,
- 14 helitorch, fusee, plastic sphere dispenser, or other hand-held
- 15 device, ground-mounted device, or aerial-mounted device with a flame
- 16 of less than three feet used to ignite fuels on the ground for
- 17 prescribed agriculture or wildland fire applications.
- 18 (3) "Permitholder" means a person who holds a flamethrowing
- 19 device permit issued by the director of fire protection pursuant to
- 20 this chapter.

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- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. Except as provided in section 3 of this act, a person may not use or possess a flamethrowing device without a valid flamethrowing device permit issued by the director of fire protection. A violation of this section is a gross misdemeanor punishable according to chapter 9A.20 RCW.
- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** This chapter does not apply to the sale, purchase, possession, transportation, storage, or use of a flamethrowing device by a person if all of the following apply:
- 9 (1) The person is regularly employed by or a paid officer or 10 employee of a fire department, fire protection district, or 11 firefighting agency of the federal government, the state, a city or 12 county, a municipal corporation, or other political subdivision of 13 the state;
- 14 (2) The person is on duty and acting within the course and scope 15 of the person's employment; and
- 16 (3) The flamethrowing device is used in the course of fire 17 suppression.

18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** The director of fire protection:

- 19 (1) Must establish by rule standards for the issuance and renewal 20 of flamethrowing device permits, including background investigation 21 requirements. At a minimum, the standards must require that:
- 22 (a) The applicant or permitholder is not addicted to any 23 controlled substance; and
- 24 (b) The applicant or permitholder is not prohibited from 25 possessing a firearm under state or federal law;
- 26 (2) Must establish by rule standards for the use, storage, and 27 transportation of flamethrowing devices; and
- 28 (3) May designate by rule fees for flamethrowing device permits 29 and permit renewals at the level necessary to cover the costs of 30 administering and enforcing the permit program.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. (1) The director of fire protection shall revoke a flamethrowing device permit if the permitholder does not comply with the requirements of this chapter and the rules adopted pursuant to this chapter.
- 35 (2) If the director of fire protection denies an application or 36 renewal application for a flamethrowing device permit, or revokes a

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- 1 flamethrowing device permit, the applicant or permitholder is
- 2 entitled to an administrative hearing pursuant to chapter 34.05 RCW.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** The director of fire protection must seize
- 4 any flamethrowing device found in the possession of a person who does
- 5 not have a valid flamethrowing device permit issued pursuant to this
- 6 chapter and who is not otherwise authorized to possess a
- 7 flamethrowing device under section 3 of this act.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** A new section is added to chapter 43.43
- 9 RCW to read as follows:
- 10 The director of fire protection shall adopt rules and carry out
- 11 other requirements related to flamethrowing devices as designated
- 12 under chapter 70.--- RCW (the new chapter created in section 8 of
- 13 this act).
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 8.** Sections 1 through 6 of this act
- 15 constitute a new chapter in Title 70 RCW.

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
