- 1 AN ACT Relating to the development of a state plan to implement
- 2 federal regulations on electric generation facilities; and adding a

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 80.80 6 RCW to read as follows:
- In developing, adopting, and implementing a state plan to comply with the requirements of the federal rule relating to greenhouse gas emissions from existing electric generation facilities published in the federal register on October 23, 2015, (80 FR 64966), the
- 11 department must select a mass-based compliance option that:
- 12 (1) Maintains state flexibility to achieve compliance using 13 market-based tools;
- 14 (2) Avoids redundant or burdensome regulation on electric 15 generation facilities by taking into consideration the greenhouse gas 16 emissions performance standard established in this chapter; and
- 17 (3) Includes participation in a regional or multistate program or 18 in interstate allowance auctions such that:
- 19 (a) The state's opportunity to realize benefit is maximized at 20 the least cost to electric generation facilities;

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	(b)	The	curre	nt (diversificati	lon	of	the	state's	electric
gen	eratio	n sou	rces is	not	diminished;	and				

(c) The state plan prioritizes the investment of any benefit that may accrue to the state in strategies to reduce the power bills of low-income families and ratepayers.

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
