1 BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of the State of 2 Washington, the Senate concurring, That immediately before 3 adjournment SINE DIE of this 2015 1st Special Session of the Sixty-4 fourth Legislature:

5 (1) The Senate shall transmit to the House of Representatives all 6 House bills, House joint resolutions, House concurrent resolutions, 7 and House joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed 8 by the Senate, and upon receipt by the House of Representatives of 9 such measures they shall be assigned to the House Rules Committee for 10 third reading; and

(2) The House of Representatives shall transmit to the Senate all 11 12 bills, Senate joint resolutions, Senate concurrent Senate 13 resolutions, and Senate joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed by the House of Representatives, and upon receipt by 14 15 the Senate of such measures they shall be assigned to the Senate 16 Rules Committee for third reading; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives shall retain in their possession and in the status that exists upon the adjournment SINE DIE of the 2015 1st Special Session of the Sixty-fourth Legislature, all legislative measures including all bills, joint resolutions, concurrent resolutions, and joint memorials that may at that time be

in their respective houses and all records, journals, dockets, and
other documents pertaining thereto; and
