WHEREAS, In 2015, over a half million people will die of cancer 1 2 in the United States making it the nation's second leading cause of 3 death; and 4 WHEREAS, Of all cancer deaths, more people in the United States 5 die from lung cancer than any other type of cancer; and 6 WHEREAS, In 2011, over 200,000 people in the United States were 7 diagnosed with lung cancer and over 150,000 people in the United 8 States died from lung cancer; and 9 WHEREAS, African American males are more likely to die from lung 10 cancer than any other racial or ethnic population; and 11 WHEREAS, While the number of deaths from cancer has declined for 12 men, except men of color, the number of lung cancer rates for women 13 have been rising; and 14 WHEREAS, In addition to the human costs, the direct medical costs 15 of cancer have been estimated to be around ninety billion dollars per 16 year, with lung cancer representing a significant portion of those 17 costs; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Washington State House 18 19 of Representatives recognize the effects that lung cancer has had on 20 Washington residents and honor those who are living with the disease 21 and those who are caring for them; and 22 IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be ΒE 23 immediately transmitted by the Chief Clerk of the House of 24 Representatives to the American Cancer Society and the Secretary of 25 the Washington State Department of Health. 26 27 I hereby certify this to be a true and correct copy of 28 Resolution 4624 adopted by the House of Representatives March 16, 2015 29 30 31 32 33
