- 1 AN ACT Relating to modifying legislators' participation on 2 regional transportation planning organization transportation policy
- 3 boards; and amending RCW 47.80.040.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.80.040 and 2003 c 351 s 1 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 Each regional transportation planning organization shall create a transportation policy board. Transportation policy boards 8 9 provide policy advice to the regional transportation planning 10 organization and shall allow representatives of major employers 11 region, the department of transportation, transit districts, port districts, and member cities, towns, and counties 12 13 within the region to participate in policy making. Any members of the 14 house of representatives or the state senate whose districts are wholly or partly within the boundaries of the regional transportation 15 16 planning organization are considered ex officio, nonvoting policy 17 board members of the regional transportation planning organization. ((This does not preclude legislators from becoming full-time, voting 18 19 board members.)) However, the most senior legislator from each

respective district, based on years of service in the legislature, is

- 2 the board are not considered for purposes of determining a quorum.
