- 1 AN ACT Relating to allowing additional liquor distributor
- 2 employees to stock liquor under certain circumstances; and amending
- 3 RCW 66.44.318.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.44.318 and 1995 c 100 s 2 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (1) Except as provided in this section, nothing is construed to
- 8 permit a nonretail class liquor licensee's employee between the ages
- 9 of eighteen and twenty-one years to handle, transport, or otherwise
- 10 possess liquor.
- 11 <u>(2)</u> Licensees holding nonretail class liquor licenses are
- 12 permitted to allow their employees between ((<del>[the]</del>)) <u>the</u> ages of
- 13 eighteen and twenty-one years to stock, merchandise, and handle
- 14 ((beer or wine)) liquor on or about the:
- 15 <u>(a) N</u>onretail premises if there is an adult twenty-one years of
- 16 age or older on duty supervising such activities on the premises; and
- 17 (b) Retail licensee's premises as long as there is an adult
- 18 <u>twenty-one years of age or older, employed by the retail licensee,</u>
- 19 and present at the retail licensee's premises during the activities
- 20 described in this subsection (2).
