- 2 and industries' fines or civil penalties; and adding a new section to

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 51.52 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 If an employer appeals a department order or decision imposing
- 8 any fine or civil penalty on the employer for failing to secure
- 9 payment of compensation under this title, failing to report the
- 10 payroll or employee hours related to employment, failing to keep and
- 11 preserve records required by this title, or misrepresenting the
- 12 amount of payroll or employee hours upon which premium is based, and
- 13 the employer prevails upon appeal before the board, or in a court
- 14 action, the department shall pay to the employer a penalty in an
- 15 amount equal to the amount of any fine and penalty determined to not
- 16 be due by a final order of the board or a court, along with
- 17 reasonable attorneys' fees and costs.
- 18 Any amount owed to an employer by the department under this
- 19 section shall be paid one-half out of the medical aid fund and one-
- 20 half out of the accident fund if the employer is insured through the

- 1 state fund, or out of the supplemental pension fund if the employer
- 2 is self-insured.
