- 1 AN ACT Relating to requiring tracking of prevailing wage surveys;
- 2 and amending RCW 39.12.026.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 39.12.026 and 2003 c 363 s 206 are each amended to read as follows:
- (1) In establishing the prevailing rate of wage under RCW 39.12.010, 39.12.015, and 39.12.020, all data collected by the department may be used only in the county for which the work was performed.
- 10 (2) This section applies only to prevailing wage surveys 11 initiated on or after August 1, 2003.
- 12 (3) The department shall keep track of the number of wage surveys
 13 the department sends and the number of responses the department
 14 receives, for each of the following categories:
 - (a) Individual contractors;

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- 16 <u>(b) Employers that directly employ and supervise workers as</u>
 17 <u>employees in building service maintenance, in shipbuilding or ship</u>
- 18 repair, in the manufacture of nonstandard items produced for public
- 19 works projects, and in the production and delivery of gravel,
