- AN ACT Relating to exempting levies imposed by qualifying flood control zone districts from certain limitations upon regular property tax levies; amending 2011 1st sp.s. c 28 s 7 (uncodified); creating a new section; and repealing 2011 c 275 ss 4 and 5 (uncodified).
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that flooding is a 7 critical problem in Washington. The legislature further finds that flooding can result in loss of human life, damage to property, 8 9 destruction of infrastructure, and bring economic activity to a 10 standstill. The legislature further finds that flood control zone 11 districts offer critical services that protect our state 12 mitigating the devastating impacts of flooding. Ιt is the 13 legislature's public policy objective to maximize available financing 14 tools to flood control zone districts to continue their important work. Therefore, it is the legislature's intent to exempt levies 15 16 imposed by a qualifying flood control zone district from certain 17 limitations upon regular property tax levies.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. 2011 c 275 ss 4 and 5 (uncodified) are each repealed.
