1 AN ACT Relating to prescription drugs and capping consumer costs; 2 adding a new section to chapter 48.43 RCW; and creating a new 3 section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. Consumers of health care services can be 6 burdened by increasing health care costs, especially for expensive 7 specialty drugs and medications to treat serious chronic diseases. It 8 is the intent of the legislature to minimize consumers' exposure to 9 high cost sharing for prescription drugs by instituting a cap on 10 individual prescription costs.

11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 48.43
12 RCW to read as follows:

13 (1) Each health plan offered that provides coverage for 14 prescription drugs shall provide a maximum cost sharing for a covered 15 outpatient prescription drug. The copayment, coinsurance, or other 16 cost sharing for an individual prescription for a supply up to thirty 17 days shall not exceed one hundred dollars.

(2) For a nongrandfathered individual or small group health plan,
 the annual deductible for outpatient drugs, if any, shall not exceed
 five hundred dollars.

1 (3) The commissioner shall recommend a schedule and methodology 2 for addressing inflationary increases that may be necessary.

3 (4) This section applies to health plans delivered, issued for 4 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2017.

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
