1 AN ACT Relating to the Dan Thompson memorial developmental
2 disabilities community trust account; and amending RCW 71A.20.170.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 71A.20.170 and 2011 1st sp.s. c 30 s 12 are each
5 amended to read as follows:

6 (1) The developmental disabilities community trust account is
7 created in the state treasury. All net proceeds from the use of
8 excess property identified in the 2002 joint legislative audit and
9 review committee capital study or other studies of the division of
10 developmental disabilities residential habilitation centers that
11 would not impact current residential habilitation center operations
12 must be deposited into the account.

13 (2)(a) Proceeds to be deposited into the account under subsection
14 (1) of this section may come from the lease of the land, conservation
15 easements, sale of timber, or other activities short of sale of the
16 property(~~(, except as permitted under section 7 of this act.~~

17 ~~(3) "Excess property" includes that portion of the property at~~
18 ~~Rainier school previously under the cognizance and control of~~
19 ~~Washington State University for use as a dairy/forage research~~
20 ~~faecility)).~~

1 (b) In addition to the proceeds from any activities under (a) of
2 this subsection, proceeds may also come from the sale of property
3 formerly used as a residential rehabilitation center. Fifty percent
4 of any proceeds under this subsection (2)(b) must be deposited into
5 the account.

6 ~~((+4))~~ (3) Only investment income from the principal of the
7 proceeds deposited into the trust account may be spent from the
8 account. For purposes of this section, "investment income" includes
9 lease payments, rent payments, or other periodic payments deposited
10 into the trust account. For purposes of this section, "principal" is
11 the actual excess land from which proceeds are assigned to the trust
12 account.

13 ~~((+5))~~ (4) Moneys in the account may be spent only after
14 appropriation. Expenditures from the account ~~((shall))~~ must be used
15 exclusively to provide family support and/or employment/day services
16 to eligible persons with developmental disabilities who can be served
17 by community-based developmental disability services. It is the
18 intent of the legislature that the account should not be used to
19 replace, supplant, or reduce existing appropriations.

21 memorial developmental disabilities community trust account.
