- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29A.08.140 and 2011 c 10 s 15 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
  - (1) In order to vote in any primary, special election, or general election, a person who is not registered to vote in Washington must:
- 9 (a) Submit a registration application no later than twenty-nine 10 days before the day of the primary, special election, or general 11 election;  $((\Theta r))$
- 12 (b) If the person is enrolled at an institution of higher 13 education, submit a registration application at that institution of 14 higher education no later than eleven days before the day of the 15 primary, special election, or general election; or
- (c) Register in person at the county auditor's office in his or her county of residence no later than eight days before the day of the primary, special election, or general election.
- 19 (2) A person who is already registered to vote in Washington may 20 update his or her registration no later than twenty-nine days before 21 the day of the primary, special election, or general election to be

- 1 in effect for that primary, special election, or general election. A
- 2 registered voter who fails to transfer his or her residential address
- 3 by this deadline may vote according to his or her previous
