TO THE HONORABLE BARACK OBAMA, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, 1 2 AND TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF 3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF 4 THE UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED, AND TO ARNE DUNCAN, 5 SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, SYLVIA MATTHEWS BURWELL, SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, UNITED 6 7 STATES ATTORNEY GENERAL ERIC HOLDER, AND THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT 8 ACCOUNTABILITY OFFICE:

9 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of 10 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, 11 respectfully represent and petition as follows:

12 WHEREAS, The prevalence of child sexual abuse by school personnel 13 and sexual abuse between peers is unknown, particularly because it 14 can go unreported; and

WHEREAS, Child sexual abuse by school personnel is especially troubling given the trust placed in schools; and

WHEREAS, Sexual abuse between peers is deeply troubling giventhat students should feel safe at school; and

WHEREAS, Federal law and Washington State law prohibit sex discrimination, including sexual harassment and abuse, in public K-12 schools; and

22 WHEREAS, The United States Government Accountability Office in 23 its report on federal agencies supporting state efforts to prevent and respond to child sexual abuse by school personnel has recommended that the Departments of Education, Health and Human Services, and Justice collaborate to compile and disseminate information to states and identify a way to track the prevalence of sexual abuse; and that the Department of Education clarify and disseminate information on how Title IX applies to personnel-to-student sexual abuse in the public K-12 school setting;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the 9 Congress, the President, and the Departments of Education, Health and 10 Human Services, and Justice take action to support and implement the 11 recommendations of the United States Government Accountability Office 12 to address personnel-to-student sexual abuse and continue to address 13 peer-to-peer sexual abuse; and

14 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately transmitted to the Honorable Barack Obama, President of the United 15 16 States, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of 17 Representatives, Arne Duncan, the Secretary of Education, Sylvia 18 Matthews Burwell, the Secretary of Health and Human Services, Eric Holder, the Attorney General of the United States, the United States 19 20 Government Accountability Office, and each member of Congress from 21 the State of Washington.
