- 1 AN ACT Relating to a feasibility study to examine whether water
- 2 storage would provide noninterruptible water resources to users of

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) The department of ecology, in
- 7 cooperation with the state department of health, Skagit county,
- 8 tribes, and nonmunicipally owned public water systems in Skagit
- 9 county, shall conduct a study to examine the feasibility of using
- 10 effectively sized water storage to recharge the Skagit river basin
- 11 when needed to meet minimum instream flows and provide
- 12 noninterruptible water resources to users of permit exempt wells
- 13 within the Skagit river basin.
- 14 (2) The department of ecology must submit a report of the study's
- 15 findings to the standing committees of the legislature with oversight
- of water resources and fiscal issues by December 1, 2016.
