- WHEREAS, Tens of millions of Americans are affected by bladder diseases and conditions including urinary incontinence, overactive bladder, underactive bladder, interstitial cystitis, nocturia, urinary tract infections, bladder cancer, urotrauma, and neurogenic

- 7 on health and quality of life contributing to depression, social
- 8 isolation, falls, sexual dysfunction, loss of self-esteem,

- 11 maintain bladder health and treat bladder diseases is critically
- 12 needed, yet poorly recognized; and

- 15 empower providers and patients to have much-needed conversations
- 16 about bladder health; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Industry professionals have strived to raise awareness
- 18 by designating November as "Bladder Health Month";
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Washington State Senate
- 20 encourage Washingtonians to view November as a valuable reminder to
- 21 take stock of their bladder health.
