3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 29A.64.090 and 2013 c 11 s 70 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 When the official canvass of returns of any election reveals that 7 the difference in the number of votes cast for the approval of a statewide measure and the number of votes cast for the rejection of 8 such measure is less than two thousand votes and also less than one-9 half of one percent of the total number of votes cast on such 10 measure, the secretary of state shall direct that a recount of all 11 votes cast on such measure be made on such measure, in the manner 12 provided by RCW 29A.64.041 and 29A.64.061, and the cost of such 13 14 recount will be at state expense. This section does not apply to any statewide advisory vote of the people that was placed on the ballot 15 16 pursuant to RCW 43.135.041 and the secretary of state shall not 17 direct any recount for any statewide advisory vote of the people.
