The director must appoint members to the working group as follows: Two members 8 9 representing labor, two members representing employers, and at least two members representing the department of labor and industries. 10 11 Members must serve without compensation but are entitled to travel expenses as provided in RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060. All expenses of 12 13 this working group must be paid by the department. The working group 14 must focus on improving the accuracy, simplicity, fairness, and consistency of calculating and providing wage replacement benefits 15 16 and shall not consider overall reductions in existing worker benefit 17 The working group must report back to the committees of the legislature by February 1, 2016, and September 1, 18 19 2016.
