- 10 (ii) Conduct forensic analysis of sexual assault examination kits
- 11 in the custody of the state patrol pursuant to Chapter 247, Laws of

- 13 (ii) Continue the task force.
- 14 (b) \$1,375,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for fiscal
- 15 year 2018 and \$1,375,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for
- 16 fiscal year 2019 are provided solely for the implementation of Chapter
- 17 247, Laws of 2015 to address the state's backlog in sexual assault
- 18 examination kits. The seven full-time employees funded under this
- 19 subsection must work exclusively on processing sexual assault exam kits
- 20 through the crime laboratory division.
- (c) Within amounts provided in this section, the Washington state
- 22 patrol shall adopt rules necessary to implement RCW 43.43.545."

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EFFECT: Conditions existing funding for the Washington State Patrol to implement the recommendations of the Joint Legislative Task Force on Sexual Assault Forensic Examination, monitor and test sexual assault examination kits, and adopt rules necessary to implement RCW 43.43.545.

FISCAL IMPACT: No net change to appropriated levels.

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
