1 On page 2, line 24, after "base" insert ";
2 (d) Shall cease offering net metering at any point that the
3 utility determines that the credit provided to net metering customers
4 is shifting cost onto residential customers who do not participate in
5 net metering such that the rate impact increases residential electric
6 utility costs on average by twenty-five dollars or more per household
7 per year"

EFFECT: An electric utility must stop offering net metering when it shifts costs and increases rates on average by \$25 or more onto residential customers who do not participate in net metering.
