1 AN ACT Relating to commercial transportation services freight 2 deliverers; and amending RCW 48.177.005.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 48.177.005 and 2016 c 21 s 1 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter 7 unless the context clearly requires otherwise.

(1) "Commercial transportation services" or "services" means all 8 9 times: (a) That the driver is logged in to a commercial 10 transportation services provider's digital network or software 11 application $((\Theta r))$; (b) until the passenger has left the $((\Theta r))$ motor vehicle; or (c) until freight is delivered at the destination, 12 whichever is later. The term does not include services provided 13 14 either directly or under contract with a political subdivision or other entity exempt from federal income tax under 26 U.S.C. Sec. 115 15 16 of the federal internal revenue code.

17 (2) "Commercial transportation services provider" means a 18 corporation, partnership, sole proprietorship, or other entity, 19 operating in Washington, that uses a digital network or software 20 application to ((connect passengers to drivers for the purpose of 21 providing)) provide a prearranged ((ride)) commercial transportation

1 service. However, a commercial transportation services provider is not a taxicab company under chapter 81.72 RCW, a charter party or 2 3 service carrier under chapter 81.70 RCW, excursion an auto transportation company under chapter 81.68 RCW, a private, nonprofit 4 transportation provider under chapter 81.66 RCW, a limousine carrier 5 б under chapter 46.72A RCW, or a commuter ride-sharing or flexible 7 commuter ride-sharing arrangement under chapter 46.74 RCW. Α commercial transportation services provider is not deemed to own, 8 control, operate, or manage the ((personal)) motor vehicles used by 9 transportation services providers. 10 commercial А commercial 11 transportation services provider does not include a political 12 subdivision or other entity exempt from federal income tax under 26 U.S.C. Sec. 115 of the federal internal revenue code. 13

14 (3) "Commercial transportation services provider driver" or 15 "driver" means an individual who uses a ((personal)) motor vehicle to 16 provide services ((for passengers matched)) through a commercial 17 transportation services provider's digital network or software 18 application.

19 (4) "Commercial transportation services provider passenger" or 20 "passenger" means a passenger in a ((personal)) motor vehicle for 21 whom transport is provided, including:

(a) An individual who uses a commercial transportation services provider's digital network or software application to connect with a driver to obtain services in the driver's vehicle for the individual and anyone in the individual's party; or

(b) Anyone for whom another individual uses a commercial transportation services provider's digital network or software application to connect with a driver to obtain services in the driver's vehicle.

30 (5) "((Personal)) Motor vehicle" means a vehicle that is used by 31 a commercial transportation services provider driver in connection 32 with providing services for a commercial transportation services 33 provider and that is authorized by the commercial transportation 34 services provider.

(6) "Prearranged ((ride)) commercial transportation service" means ((a route)) the transportation of ((travel)) passengers or property between points chosen by the passenger or shipper and arranged with a driver through the use of a commercial transportation services provider's digital network or software application. The ((ride)) prearranged commercial transportation service begins when a

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1 driver accepts a ((requested ride)) <u>dispatch</u> through a digital 2 network or software application, continues while the driver 3 transports the passenger <u>or property</u> in a ((personal)) <u>motor</u> vehicle, 4 and ends when the passenger departs from the ((personal)) <u>motor</u> 5 vehicle <u>or the property is tendered at delivery</u>.

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
