- 9 courts, supreme court commissioners, court of appeals commissioners,
- 10 superior court commissioners, judges of courts of limited
- jurisdiction as defined in RCW 3.02.010, judges of tribal courts, and
- 12 any regularly licensed or ordained minister or any priest, imam,
- 13 rabbi, or similar official of any religious organization((, and
- 14 judges of courts of limited jurisdiction as defined in RCW
