- 10 action as is reasonably necessary to prevent physical injury to a
- 11 person or substantial damage to property or prevent further injury to
- 12 a person or further substantial damage to property. A designated
- 12 a person or further substantial damage to property. A designated
- officer shall be immune from civil liability for damages arising out
- of the action of the designated officer to prevent physical injury to a person or substantial damage to property or prevent further injury
- to a person or further substantial damage to property, unless it is
- 17 shown that the designated officer acted with gross negligence or bad
- 18 faith.
