- AN ACT Relating to specifying that certain types of changes to the allowable uses of a right-of-way are not subject to the requirements of the state environmental policy act; and adding a new

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.21C 7 RCW to read as follows:
- 8 (1) An action by a lead agency that results in the amendment of 9 the allowable uses of an existing right-of-way is not subject to the 10 requirements of this chapter if the following conditions are met:
- 11 (a) The action does not result in a physical alteration to the 12 right-of-way; and
- 13 (b) The action does not newly allow the use of the right-of-way 14 by a heavier class of vehicles than have historically used the right-15 of-way.
- 16 (2) The classes of vehicles that an action exempt under 17 subsection (1) of this section may newly authorize the use of 18 include, but are not limited to, golf carts.
