9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** This act may be known and cited as the
11 expanding the current and future educator workforce supply through
12 evidence-based strategies to improve and incentivize the recruitment
13 and retention of highly effective educators, especially in high-need
14 subject, grade-level, and geographic areas, and to establish a
15 cohesive continuum of high quality professional learning from
16 preparation programs to job embedded induction, mentoring,
17 collaboration, and other professional development opportunities act.
