- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.70 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The department shall adopt a standard disclaimer form for 8 each vaccine approved by the federal food and drug administration 9 that informs patients:
- 10 (a) That a person who is vaccinated may inadvertently carry the 11 disease that it was intended to protect against and that it may 12 expose vulnerable populations to the disease;
 - (b) That the receipt of a vaccination is not a guarantee of protection against the disease that it was intended to protect against; and
- 16 (c) Of the known effectiveness rate of the particular vaccine, 17 the expected duration of the protection, and the possibility that a 18 person may become infected with the targeted disease.
- 19 (2) Each health care provider who holds a license issued by a 20 disciplining authority under RCW 18.130.040 must provide a patient 21 with the relevant disclaimer form adopted pursuant to subsection (1)
