- 1 AN ACT Relating to the crime of endangerment with a controlled 2 substance; amending RCW 9A.42.100; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.42.100 and 2005 c 218 s 4 are each amended to read as follows:
- (1) A person is guilty of the crime of endangerment with a controlled substance if the person knowingly or intentionally permits a dependent child or dependent adult to be exposed to, ingest, inhale, or have contact with ((methamphetamine)):
- 10 <u>(a) Any controlled substance listed in Schedule I under RCW</u>
 11 <u>69.50.204 or in Schedule II under RCW 69.50.206, unless the exposure,</u>
 12 ingestion, inhalation, or contact is in accordance with a valid
- 13 prescription or order; or
- (b) Ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, or anhydrous ammonia, including their salts, isomers, and salts of isomers, that are being used in the manufacture of methamphetamine, including its salts, isomers, and salts of isomers.
- 18 (2) Endangerment with a controlled substance is a class B felony.
