## SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 2952

1 AN ACT Relating to officially naming a recreational trail; and 2 creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The legislature hereby directs the city of
Spokane Valley to rename the portion of the Milwaukee road corridor
in the city of Spokane Valley known as the Appleway trail the
"Senator Bob McCaslin trail."

8 The state shall provide and install a proper marker in a 9 suitable location in at least one main activity area of the trail 10 identifying the name of the trail. The state parks and recreation 11 commission shall incur all costs associated with the provision and 12 installation of the sign. The city is not obligated to change any 13 signage that existed as of the effective date of this act, or to 14 provide additional signage.

The legislature finds that it is appropriate to so honor Senator Bob McCaslin for his thirty years of dedicated service to the people of this state.
