WHEREAS, According to the Iraq and Afghanistan Veterans of America, there are 2.4 million veterans of the Iraq and Afghanistan conflicts nationwide; and

18 WHEREAS, Veterans from Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Bangor Sub Base, Bremerton Naval Station, and others served honorably in the Iraq and 19 20 Afghanistan conflicts, some of whom died or were injured during the 14 to 16 years of ongoing operations there; and 21

WHEREAS, The Brown Farm Road Northeast bridge at exit 114 over 22 23 I-5 is currently unnamed; and

p. 1 HJM 4018 1 WHEREAS, Signage in the vicinity of the bridge at exit 114 over 2 I-5 would be a visible display of honor and gratitude for active 3 duty, former, and retired veterans of the Iraq and Afghanistan 4 conflicts and their families; and
