  - (1) A purchaser of privately owned timber in an amount in excess of two hundred thousand board feet in a voluntary sale made in the ordinary course of business must, on or before the last day of the month following the purchase of the timber, report the particulars of the purchase to the department as required in subsection (2) of this section.
- (2) The report required in subsection (1) of this section must 13 14 contain all information relevant to the value of the timber purchased limited to, the following, 15 including, but not applicable: as 16 Purchaser's name, address, and contact information; seller's name, 17 address, and contact information; sale date; termination date in sale agreement; total sale price; legal description of sale area, sale 18 name if applicable; forest practice application/harvest permit number 19 20 if available; total acreage involved in the sale; estimated net 21 volume of timber purchased by tree species and log grade; and
