5 2017 4A Girls Basketball Championship; and

7 Kentridge Chargers to a 60-46 victory over Glacier Peak in the title
8 game; and

9 WHEREAS, The Chargers made history by winning their first
10 championship for their high school and the community; and

11 WHEREAS, The Chargers' commitment to preparation and to each
12 other is a prime example of overcoming adversity; and

13 WHEREAS, Head Coach Bob Sandall established a culture of
14 dedication and collaboration that guided the Chargers through a long
15 season and into the championship game; and

16 WHEREAS, The Chargers' road to victory was paved by the boundless
17 support of their families and the Kentridge community;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives
19 honor the Kentridge Chargers Girls Basketball team, whose dedication,

21 Girls Basketball State Title; and
