3 high school principals from regional finalists from across the state;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, The Assistant Principal of the Year earns the respect
6 and admiration of their colleagues, is an expert in their field,
7 guides teachers and students to excellence, and collaborates with
8 colleagues, students, and families; and

9 WHEREAS, The Assistant Principal of the Year demonstrates
10 leadership and innovation in their school and embodies leadership
11 development among both school administrators and students; and

12 WHEREAS, The Assistant Principal of the Year represents
13 Washington state at all National Assistant Principal of the Year
14 events; and

15 WHEREAS, The Assistant Principal of the Year meets or exceeds
16 eight specific criteria to be selected: Creating culture in the
17 workplace, ensuring school safety, planning with data, aligning
18 curriculum, improving instruction, managing resources, engaging
19 communities, and closing the gap; and

20 WHEREAS, The honor of being named Washington State Assistant
21 Principal of the Year is representative of leadership excellence in
22 Washington state schools and the dedication of teachers,
23 administrators, and families for student success in learning;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives
2 demonstrate its deep respect and appreciation for the 2018 Washington
3 State Assistant Principal of the Year, Tami Skillingstad, of Cheney
4 School District for her years of teaching excellence, leadership
5 development, and curriculum alignment; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives
7 recognize the value and dedication of all Washington state education
8 administrators and educators embodied in this most prestigious award;
