- AN ACT Relating to requiring the department of health to develop a hearing loss education program for health care professionals; and
- 3 adding a new section to chapter 43.70 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.70 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 The department, in consultation with the disciplining authorities as defined in RCW 18.130.040, must establish an ongoing 8 hearing loss educational program as an integral part of its health 9 10 professions regulation. The educational program must train health 11 care professionals in identifying hearing loss in older adults and must include symptoms of hearing loss such as being noncommunicative, 12 13 not responding to direct questions, or responding inappropriately to 14 direct questions. The hearing loss educational program must be developed in collaboration with education programs 15 that 16 students in that health profession. A disciplining authority may 17 instructors of continuing education or continuing require that competency programs integrate the educational program into their 18 19 curricula when it is appropriate to the subject matter of 20 instruction, with special emphasis on those health care professions

who are likely to work with older adults or adults displaying symptoms of dementia.

(2) No funds from the health professions account may be used to fund activities under this section unless the disciplining authority authorizes expenditures from its proportions of the account. A disciplining authority may defray costs by authorizing a fee to be charged for participants or materials relating to any sponsored program.
