- 1 AN ACT Relating to protection for occupants of national guard
- 2 facilities; and adding a new section to chapter 38.40 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 38.40 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Subject to the availability of amounts appropriated for this 7 specific purpose, the military department shall provide adequate protection for occupants of national guard facilities. For the 8 purposes of this section, national guard facilities means recruiting 9 10 offices and other facilities not located on a secure military 11 installation. Adequate protection is determined by an assessment of possible threats and vulnerabilities of a facility. Adequate measures 12 to protect occupants include, but are not limited to: 13
- 14 (a) The use of armed security personnel;
- 15 (b) Security cameras;
- 16 (c) Locking devices;
- 17 (d) Obscuration;
- 18 (e) Ballistic barriers;
- 19 (f) Soft body armor;
- 20 (g) Magnetometers;
- 21 (h) Other protective equipment; and

- 1 (i) Specialized training in avoiding, preparing, or responding to threats facing national guard facilities.
- 3 (2) With the exception of subsection (1)(a) of this section, the 4 cost of providing these protections will be one time.
 - (3) This section does not create a private right of action.
