1 AN ACT Relating to compensating associated student body programs  
2 from revenue losses from student body program food or beverage sales  
3 in schools; and adding a new section to chapter 28A.325 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.325  
6 RCW to read as follows:

7 Beginning with the 2017-18 school year, if an associated student  
8 body program has incurred a revenue loss from food or beverage sales  
9 in school during school hours or for school-sponsored activities,  
10 including food sold a la carte, in school stores, and in vending  
11 machines, the state must compensate the associated student body  
12 program fund in an amount equal to the largest annual loss of revenue  
13 since the school district's implementation of state or federal rules  
14 or regulations for healthy food and beverage sales in schools. The  
15 state must compensate the associated student body fund annually on a  
16 schedule determined by the state.
