- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 28A.150 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) All public schools must offer students the opportunity to 7 compost their food waste. School districts must have the choice to 8 either provide on-site composting or contracting out with the local 9 waste management company.
- 10 (2) All public schools in the state must offer their students the 11 opportunity to recycle.
- 12 (3) The state must provide free pickup of compost and provide 13 supplies such as bins and compost bags for all public schools that do 14 not currently have the pickup and supplies needed.
