- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.157.005 and 2009 c 421 s 1 are each amended to read as follows:
- The legislature declares that certain private investments, such 8 industrial 9 as investments for development, transportation, environmental improvement, and innovation activities, merit special 10 11 designation ((and treatment by governmental bodies when they are proposed)) as projects of statewide significance. Such investments 12 13 bolster the economies of their locale and impact the economy of the 14 state as a whole. It is the intention of the legislature to recognize projects of statewide significance, to provide a mechanism for local 15 16 governments and state and federal agencies to perform a coordinated and comprehensive review of such projects, and to encourage ((local 17 18 governments and state agencies to expedite)) their expeditious

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- 1 **Sec. 2.** RCW 43.157.010 and 2012 c 63 s 2 are each reenacted and 2 amended to read as follows:
- The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter and RCW 28A.525.166, ((28B.76.210, 28C.18.080,)) 43.21A.350, and 90.58.100, unless the context <u>clearly</u> requires otherwise:
- 6 (1) "Applicant" means a person applying to the department for 7 designation of a development project as a project of statewide 8 significance.
- 9 (2) "Aviation biofuels production facility" means a facility
 10 primarily for the processing of nonfossil biogenic feedstocks to
 11 produce aviation fuels that meet the fuel quality technical standards
 12 of the American society for testing materials for aviation fuels and
 13 coproducts.
 - (3) "Department" means the department of commerce.

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- 15 (4) "Manufacturing" ((shall have)) has the meaning assigned it in 16 RCW 82.62.010.
 - (5)(a) "Project of statewide significance" means:
- 18 (i) A border crossing project that involves both private and 19 public investments carried out in conjunction with adjacent states or 20 provinces;
- 21 (ii) A development project that will provide a net environmental 22 benefit to the state or a region of the state;
- 23 (iii) A development project in furtherance of the 24 commercialization of innovations;
- 25 (iv) A private industrial development with private capital 26 investment in manufacturing, transportation, development of a 27 renewable resource, environmental conservation or efficiency, or 28 research and development; or
- 29 (v) An aviation biofuels production facility.
- 30 (b) To qualify for designation under RCW 43.157.030 as a project 31 of statewide significance:
 - (i) The project must be completed after January 1, 2009;
- (ii) The applicant must submit an application to the department for designation as a project of statewide significance ((to the department of commerce)); and
- 36 (iii) Except for an aviation biofuels production facility, the 37 project must have:
- 38 (A) In counties with a population less than or equal to twenty 39 thousand, a capital investment of five million dollars;

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- 1 (B) In counties with a population greater than twenty thousand 2 but no more than fifty thousand, a capital investment of ten million 3 dollars;
- 4 (C) In counties with a population greater than fifty thousand but 5 no more than one hundred thousand, a capital investment of fifteen 6 million dollars;
 - (D) In counties with a population greater than one hundred thousand but no more than two hundred thousand, a capital investment of twenty million dollars;

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- 10 (E) In counties with a population greater than two hundred 11 thousand but no more than four hundred thousand, a capital investment 12 of thirty million dollars;
- 13 (F) In counties with a population greater than four hundred 14 thousand but no more than one million, a capital investment of forty 15 million dollars;
- 16 (G) In counties with a population greater than one million, a 17 capital investment of fifty million dollars;
- 18 (H) In rural counties as defined by RCW 82.14.370, projected 19 full-time employment positions after completion of construction of 20 ((fifty)) thirty or greater;
- 21 (I) In counties other than rural counties as defined by RCW 22 82.14.370, projected full-time employment positions after completion of construction of ((one hundred)) seventy or greater; ((or))
- 24 (J) <u>If the project will create jobs in both rural and nonrural</u> 25 <u>counties, projected full-time employment positions after completion</u> 26 <u>of construction of seventy or greater; or</u>
- 27 <u>(K)</u> Been qualified by the director of the department as a project 28 of statewide significance either because:
- 29 (I) The economic circumstances of the county <u>or region</u> merit the 30 additional assistance such designation will bring;
- 31 (II) The impact on a <u>county or</u> region due to the size and 32 complexity of the project merits such designation;
 - (III) The project resulted from or is in furtherance of innovation activities at a public research institution in the state or is in or resulted from innovation activities within an innovation partnership zone; or
 - (IV) The project will provide a net environmental benefit as evidenced by plans for design and construction under green building standards or for the creation of renewable energy technology or components or under other environmental criteria established by the

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- 1 director in consultation with the director of the department of 2 ecology.
- 3 (c) A project may be qualified under (b)(iii)(K) of this 4 subsection $(5)((\frac{b}{(iii)}(J)))$ only after consultation on the 5 availability of staff resources of the office of regulatory 6 assistance.
- 7 (6) "Research and development" ((shall have)) has the meaning 8 assigned it in RCW 82.62.010.
- 9 (7) "Renewable resource" means (a) wind; (b) solar energy; (c)
 10 geothermal energy; (d) landfill gas; (e) gas from sewage treatment
 11 facilities; (f) biodiesel fuel as defined in RCW 82.29A.135 that is
 12 not derived from crops raised on land cleared from old growth or
 13 first-growth forests where the clearing occurred after December 7,
 14 2006; or (g) biomass energy.
- 15 <u>(8) "Transportation" means a project to improve or repair a</u>
 16 <u>highway or road, approaches to a highway, highway ramps, and parking</u>
 17 <u>facilities. Transportation does not include conveyance of</u>
 18 construction materials.
- 19 **Sec. 3.** RCW 43.157.020 and 2009 c 421 s 3 are each amended to 20 read as follows:

Counties and cities with development projects designated as projects of statewide significance within their jurisdictions ((shall)) must enter into an agreement with the office of regulatory assistance and the project managers of projects of statewide significance for: Expediting the completion of a project((s)) of statewide significance; and completing a coordinated and comprehensive review of a project of statewide significance. The agreement ((shall)) must require:

- 29 (1) Expedited permit processing for the design and construction 30 of the project;
 - (2) Expedited environmental review processing;

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- (3) Expedited <u>and consolidated</u> processing of requests for street, right-of-way, ((or)) easement vacations, or other local <u>administrative permits</u> necessary for the construction of the project;
- 35 (4) Participation of local officials on the team assembled under 36 the requirements of RCW 43.157.030(2)(b); and
- 37 (5) Such other actions or items as are deemed necessary by the 38 office of regulatory assistance for the design and construction of

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- 1 the project but that do not alter any agency or local government
- 2 permitting authority or other existing statutory requirements.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is known as the community
- 4 prosperity and revitalization act.

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
