- A health benefit plan issued, delivered, or renewed in this state 7 that, as a provision of hospital, medical, or surgical services,
- directly or indirectly covers the treatment of stage four advanced, 9
- 10 metastatic cancer shall not limit or exclude coverage for a drug
- 11 approved by the United States food and drug administration by
- 12 mandating that the insured shall first be required to fail
- successfully respond to a different drug or drugs or prove a history 13
- 14 of failure of such drug or drugs; unless the use of such drug or
- drugs is consistent with best practices for the treatment of stage 15
- 16 four advanced, metastatic cancer and is supported by peer-reviewed
