- 1 AN ACT Relating to regional transit authority capital project
- 2 reauthorization; adding a new section to chapter 81.112 RCW; and
- 3 creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. It is the intent of the legislature that
- 6 regional transit authority voters are given an opportunity to
- 7 reaffirm or withdraw their support for an authority to continue
- 8 collecting revenue and constructing capital projects if any capital
- 9 projects are delivered at greater than twenty percent over the
- 10 original project cost estimate.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 81.112
- 12 RCW to read as follows:
- 13 An authority must provide initial engineer estimates for the cost
- 14 to complete each capital project within a voter-approved capital
- 15 program on its web site or another publicly accessible location. If
- 16 two years after beginning construction of a voter-approved capital
- 17 program the overall capital program budget is found to be greater
- 18 than twenty percent over the initial estimate, an authority must
- 19 place on the next ballot a ballot proposition to reauthorize any
