- AN ACT Relating to requiring a taxpayer accountability statement to be included with regional transit authority property taxes; adding a new section to chapter 36.29 RCW; creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. In November 2016, the voters within the 7 sound transit district approved a fifty-four billion dollar, taxpayer-funded light rail, heavy rail, and bus expansion in the 8 9 Puget Sound region. Ensuring that taxpayers understand how funds 10 collected by sound transit are used is critical to achieving trust 11 between the agency and the public. The legislature finds that the 12 opportunities to provide transparency and understanding regarding the 13 use of taxpayer dollars should be maximized. To achieve this end, a 14 sound transit taxpayer accountability statement will be placed on the property tax notifications provided by the counties, which will 15 16 contain easy-to-access and easy-to-understand information on sound 17 transit project status and financial audits.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 36.29
 RCW to read as follows:

p. 1 SB 5909

- 1 (1) The county treasurer or, in the case of a home rule county,
 2 the county official designated by county charter and ordinance as the
 3 official with custody over the collection of countywide tax revenues,
 4 shall include a taxpayer accountability statement regarding the
 5 appropriate regional transit authority when notification is sent to
 6 any person regarding the amount of tax levied under RCW 81.104.175 by
 7 the regional transit authority.
- 8 (2) For purposes of this section, a taxpayer accountability 9 statement must include the following:
- 10 (a) A statement indicating which of the regional transit 11 authority's projects are in scope, on time, and on budget and which 12 are not;
- 13 (b) A link or web site address to audited financial statements 14 for the regional transit authority;
- 15 (c) A link or web site address to fiscal information on the 16 regional transit authority's projects; and
- 17 (d) The number of a hotline to be provided by the department of 18 licensing to expedite contact with the appropriate regional transit 19 authority.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect immediately.
