- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 72.05

  RCW to read as follows:
  - (1) The department may provide residential custody services in a state juvenile rehabilitation facility to youth adjudicated and sentenced by a court of any federally recognized Indian tribe located within the state of Washington, pursuant to a contract between the department and the tribe that is entered into in compliance with the interlocal cooperation act, chapter 39.34 RCW.
    - (2) As used in this section:
- 13 (a) "Residential custody services" means a comprehensive program 14 established pursuant to RCW 72.05.130 for the custody, care, education. 15 treatment, instruction, quidance, control, and 16 rehabilitation of youth committed to a state juvenile rehabilitation 17 facility.
- 18 (b) "State juvenile rehabilitation facility" means an institution 19 as defined in RCW 13.40.020(13), a community facility as defined in
