- 2 new section to chapter 28A.320 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 28A.320 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) All public schools may offer students the opportunity to 7 compost their food waste. School districts may provide on-site 8 composting or contracting out with the local waste management 9 company.
- 10 (2) All public schools may offer students the opportunity to 11 recycle.
- 12 (3) The state may provide free pickup of compost and provide 13 supplies such as bins and compost bags for all public schools that do 14 not currently have the pickup and supplies needed.
