- 1 AN ACT Relating to medical assistant credential fees; and
- 2 amending RCW 18.360.070.

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- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.360.070 and 2012 c 153 s 8 are each amended to read as follows:
  - (1) In addition to any other authority provided by law, the secretary may:
- 8 (a) Adopt rules, in accordance with chapter 34.05 RCW, necessary 9 to implement this chapter;
- 10 (b) Establish forms and procedures necessary to administer this 11 chapter;
- 12 (c) Establish administrative procedures, administrative 13 requirements, and fees in accordance with RCW 43.70.250 and
- 43.70.280((. Until July 1, 2016, for purposes of setting fees under
- 15 this section, the secretary shall consider persons registered or
- 16 certified under this chapter and health care assistants, certified
- 17 under chapter 18.135 RCW, as one profession));
- 18 (d) Hire clerical, administrative, and investigative staff as 19 needed to implement and administer this chapter;
- 20 (e) Maintain the official department of health record of all applicants and credential holders; and

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1 (f) Establish requirements and procedures for an inactive 2 registration or certification.

- (2) In establishing fees pursuant to subsection (1)(c) of this section, the secretary may not require a person to pay a registration, certification, or licensure fee more than once, including any fees for receiving an initial medical assistant credential, within a two-year renewal cycle.
- (3) The uniform disciplinary act, chapter 18.130 RCW, governs unlicensed practice, the issuance and denial of a registration or certification, and the discipline of persons registered or certified under this chapter.

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
