- 2 fish and wildlife the authority to issue permits to the Wanapum
- 3 Indians for other freshwater food fish for ceremonial and subsistence
- 4 purposes; and amending RCW 77.12.453.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.12.453 and 1983 1st ex.s. c 46 s 27 are each 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 The director may issue permits to members of the Wanapum band of
- 9 Indians to take salmon and other freshwater food fish for ceremonial
- 10 and subsistence purposes. The department shall establish the areas in
- 11 which the permits are valid and shall regulate the times for and
- 12 manner of taking the salmon and other freshwater food fish. This
- 13 section does not create a right to fish commercially.
