- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.300 6 RCW to read as follows:
- Subject to the availability of amounts appropriated for this
- 8 specific purpose, the superintendent of public instruction must
- 9 convene a work group to update the environmental and sustainability
- 10 literacy plan in existence on the effective date of this section and
- 11 develop grade appropriate model lessons that connect to adopted state
- 12 standards.
- 13 (1) The work group must:
- 14 (a) Include representatives from a variety of sectors, including
- 15 but not limited to teachers, agencies, environmental groups, and
- 16 business representatives;
- 17 (b) Convene at least three but no more than five times;
- 18 (c) Update the environmental and sustainability literacy plan by
- 19 August 1, 2019; and
