2 serving the State of Washington since 2007 as a coalition of
3 providers in every corner of the state; and

4 WHEREAS, WIN 2-1-1 provides information and referral services to
5 anyone in need of essential health and human services such as
6 training, employment, food pantries, help for the elderly and
7 individuals with disabilities, affordable housing, support groups,
8 and other ways for people to connect to their community; and

9 WHEREAS, WIN 2-1-1 provides real-time tracking of community
10 needs, allowing policy makers and funders to make informed decisions
11 about resource allocation; and

12 WHEREAS, WIN 2-1-1 supports approximately 291 million people in
13 all fifty states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico working
14 to ensure that every American has access to services they need; and

15 WHEREAS, WIN 2-1-1 takes the calls of volunteers and those who
16 wish to donate in times of crisis, allowing first responders to focus
17 on relief efforts;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Washington State Senate
19 celebrate the tenth anniversary of WIN 2-1-1 and the necessary
20 service it provides to the residents of Washington state; and

23 Manager, Tim Sullivan, of Washington Information Network 2-1-1.
