7 (1) The department, county auditor or other agent, or subagent 8 appointed by the director shall collect a service fee of:

9 (a) Twelve dollars for changes in a certificate of title((, with 10 or without registration renewal,)) or for verification of record and 11 preparation of an affidavit of lost title other than at the time of 12 the certificate of title application or transfer, in addition to any 13 other fees or taxes due at the time of application; and

(b) Five dollars for a registration renewal, issuing a transit
permit, or any other service under this section, in addition to any
other fees or taxes due at the time of application.

17 (2) Service fees collected under this section by the department 18 or county auditor or other agent appointed by the director must be 19 credited to the capital vessel replacement account under RCW 20 47.60.322.
